IPS Conversions

When searching for a patient on PAS you may find one matching the details entered that displays the message *DO NOT USE* (I P S C O N V) – at the top of the Patient Main Details screen. These patients have minimal details entered i.e. name, date of birth.

- If you do find the patient after completing other searches and they are fully registered ensure the details are correct and update if required.
