## Overview

The medication history can be made up of two medication event types: medication statements and orders.

The Medications Viewer can be accessed from the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV) or from the Medications dashboard card within the Clinical Summary screen.

Selecting 'table' view will present further details such as the number of times that medication has been prescribed, whether the medication is on record or perhaps dispensed as a discharge medication for example. The information will be presented in chronological order.

By default, the last 12 months of information is displayed with the option to view all dates.
